

KEEPING YOU SAFE

For Buyers

To ensure your safety at this event we are putting in place a number of measures. These will involve limiting the number of tables, the number of people on the site at any one time so that we are able to ensure social distancing in accordance with the prevailing recommendations and steps to make the changing of money contactless.

- The site will open at 9.00 and will close at 12.00.
- Entry will be by donation into a bucket on a pay whatever, although we would like to suggest either 50p or £1.00 per person.
- This will ensure no cash changes hands at the gate.
- One of us will be at the entrance to count the number of people entering to enable us to ensure social distancing is possible.
- On entry you will take a form for use in purchasing items. We ask that you bring your own pen to keep tabs of what you have bought to avoid potential cross contamination.
- When you have agreed with a seller the item and price you will record this on the form and the seller will stamp it.
- You will then be able to take the item away from the table.
- You will do this for every item purchased and at any table.
- Each seller will have a unique stamp.
- When you wish to leave you will need to go to the table at the entrance to the theatre where a copy of your form will be made, the total spend calculated and you will be asked to **pay by contactless card**.
- On completion of the purchases we will receipt the form.
- This will need to be shown at the exit before leaving the site.
- All our people will be wearing masks and gloves and we strongly request that you do so as well.
- This request will also be made of the sellers and everyone will be reminded to keep safe distances.
- There will also be hand sanitising stations on the site for additional protection.
- There will be parking available opposite the site for those people of disability and this will be monitored as spaces are limited.
